These Peace Poles are now proudly installed at Adelaide High School, Keithcot Farm Primary School, and more to come – standing as symbols of hope, unity, and shared values across our community.

I also support crisis outreach through TR Helpline and serve on the team at the Adelaide Multicultural Sports
