The Indian-Australian Opportunity

The Challenge

Polling from RedBridge Group Australia, published in The Indian Sun (August 2025), shows that despite their strong alignment with Liberal values, the overwhelming majority of Indian-Australians are voting Labor. Nationally, 85% of voters from the Indian Subcontinent community supported Labor at the last federal election.


This is not because they oppose enterprise, family or opportunity, values they strongly share with us, but because too many feel taken for granted or unwelcome. The warning from pollster Kos Samaras is clear: "They are socially conservative, aspirational, small business entrepreneurs, and yet they vote Labor. They told us: 'They don't like us."

The Opportunity for South Australia

The growth of the Indian Subcontinent community in South Australia is striking. The data tells the story: in just a decade, the Indian-born population alone has more than doubled, with strong growth also from Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, and other countries across the region.

These are families who are building small businesses, raising children with a focus on education, and investing in South Australia's future. They are exactly the kind of voters the Liberal Party should be winning over, but only if we make the effort to engage, respect, and include them.
